Prescribed Funeral Goods and Services

Professional Service Fee

Our professional service fee covers our personal care and guidance, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, transfer within 50km of Mason Park Funerals, arranging and conducting the funeral service or direct disposition in accordance with your wishes, within business hours 9:00am - 5:00pm, Monday to Friday (excl public holidays) and more.

Full inclusions for our professional service fees are listed on pages 7 and 8 of this document.

Service fee is dependant on the type of service required as listed below.

Single Service Fee - where the service is held in it's entirety at one venue, being a chapel, church, crematorium chapel, graveside, home or other venue, followed by an unattended burial or cremation. Includes transfer and travel within 50km of Mason Park Funerals. Please see page 7 for full inclusions.	\$5,525
Dual Service Fee - where the service is held at one venue being a chapel, church, crematorium chapel, home or other venue, followed or preceded by an attended burial or cremation. Includes transfer and travel within 50km of Mason Park Funerals. Please see page 7 for full inclusions.	\$5,750
Direct Disposition Fee - where there is no service, attendance or viewing. Includes transfer and travel within 50km of Mason Park Funerals. Please see page 8 for full inclusions.	\$3,370
Memorial Service Fee - where burial or cremation has been undertaken and paid for at another funeral home. Monday to Friday 9:00am to 3:00pm (excl public holidays). Includes travel within 50km of Mason Park Funerals. Please see page 8 for full inclusions.	\$3,095
Extended Service Fee - catering between service and committal, committal previous/following day etc. Respective Service Fee (single/dual) plus: NOTE - Services requiring staff to stay out of town overnight will also incur accomodation and meal charges at cost.	\$255

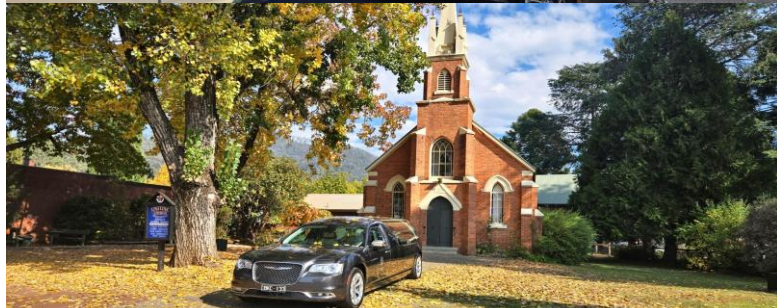
